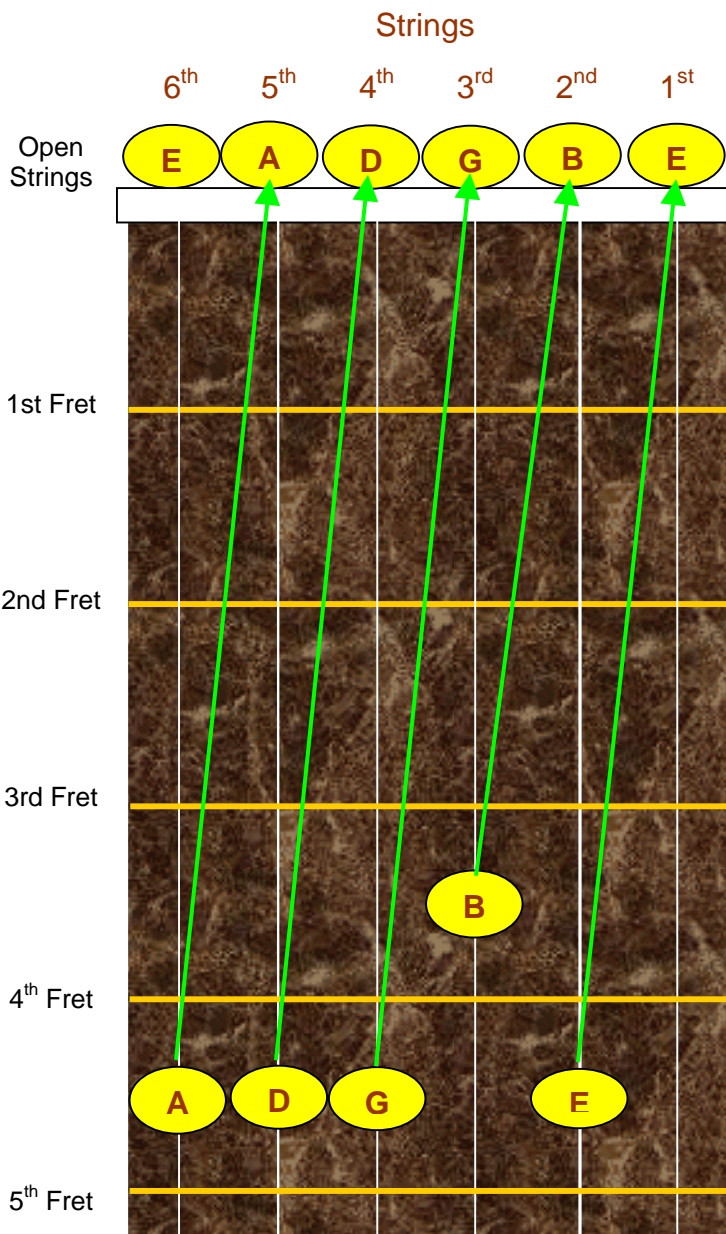


# Deejay's Tuning Chart



Placing your finger behind the;

5<sup>th</sup> fret on the 6<sup>th</sup> string produces the **A** note for the 5<sup>th</sup> string

5<sup>th</sup> fret on the 5<sup>th</sup> string produces the **D** note for the 4<sup>th</sup> string

5<sup>th</sup> fret on the 6<sup>th</sup> string produces the **G** note for the 3<sup>rd</sup> string

4<sup>th</sup> fret on the 6<sup>th</sup> string produces the **B** note for the 2<sup>nd</sup> string

5<sup>th</sup> fret on the 6<sup>th</sup> string produces the **E** note for the 1<sup>st</sup> string

The 6<sup>th</sup> string E and the 1<sup>st</sup> string E are an octave apart
